## **Voters encouraged to cast a ballot in the Nov. 7 Consolidated General Election**

Tuesday (Nov. 7) is Election Day for Riverside County residents registered to vote in the Consolidated General Election. Voters will be able to cast ballots at 51 polling places. To find your assigned polling place, please go to the Registrar of Voters' website at [www.voteinfo.net](http://www.voteinfo.net) or call (951) 486-7200. Polls are open from 7 a.m. through 8 p.m.

The Nov. 7 election is not a countywide election, so some areas of the county are not included in the election. Call the registrar's office at (951) 486-7200 if you have questions about your eligibility to vote.

You also may cast a ballot in the Registrar of Voters office on Election Day between the hours of 7 a.m. and 8 p.m. The Registrar of Voters office is located at 2724 Gateway Drive in Riverside.

All ballots, including vote-by-mail ballots, must be received at the Registrar of Voters Office or any polling place within Riverside County no later than the close of polls on Election Day or be postmarked on or before Election Day and received no later than three days after Election Day to be counted.

Registrar of Voters, Rebecca Spencer, encourages every eligible voter to cast a ballot in the election.
