First day you can vote. Each eligible registered voter will begin receiving their ballot by mail beginning this day.



Registration Deadline. Check your registration status online or by calling our office.



Early Voting available at the Registrar of Voters office from 8:00 a.m. - 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday (excluding holidays).



Election Day!

Mail in or drop off your Vote-by-Mail ballot by today! Mailed-in ballots must be postmarked by this date and received no later than November 9 to be counted.

In-person voting also available at your assigned Polling Place or the Registrar of Voters office.

Ballot-Drop off locations at City Clerk Offices, Polling Places and the Registrar of Voters office open from 7:00 a.m. - 8:00 p.m.
