STUDENT POLLWORKERS ARE NEEDED EXPERIENCE NOT REQUIRED!

California Elections Code (section § 12302b) encourages High School students to serve as Election Officers on Election Day "...In order to provide for a greater awareness of the elections process."

Student Pollworkers are paid a stipend (up to \$110) for working on Election Day.

What will I do as a Student Pollworker?

- ★ Assist with Election Eve and Day setup
- ★ Arrive promptly at 6:15 am Election Morning
- ★ Serve the voting public with patience, understanding, and excellent customer service
- ★ Assist voters in locating their correct polling place
- ★ Inform limited English speaking voters that voting documents are available in their language
- ★ Assist with closing procedures by counting ballots and completing closing documents

I meet the qualifications to serve as a Student Pollworker. Now what do I do?

- ★ Contact your Social Studies or Spanish teacher and ask for a "Nomination Form" or you may visit our website at www.voteinfo.net and download a Nomination Form.
- ★ Submit a completed Nomination Form to the Registrar of Voters office via fax or regular mail
- ★ Upon selection, the Registrar of Voters will schedule Student Pollworkers a required training class.

Riverside County's population is growing and so is the demand for interpreters at polling places on Election Day. The Registrar of Voters has a great demand for Student Pollworkers with bilingual skills in the Spanish, Tagalog, Korean, Chinese, and Vietnamese languages. Bilingual Student Pollworkers assist limited English proficient voters at the polls to facilitate effective participation in elections.
